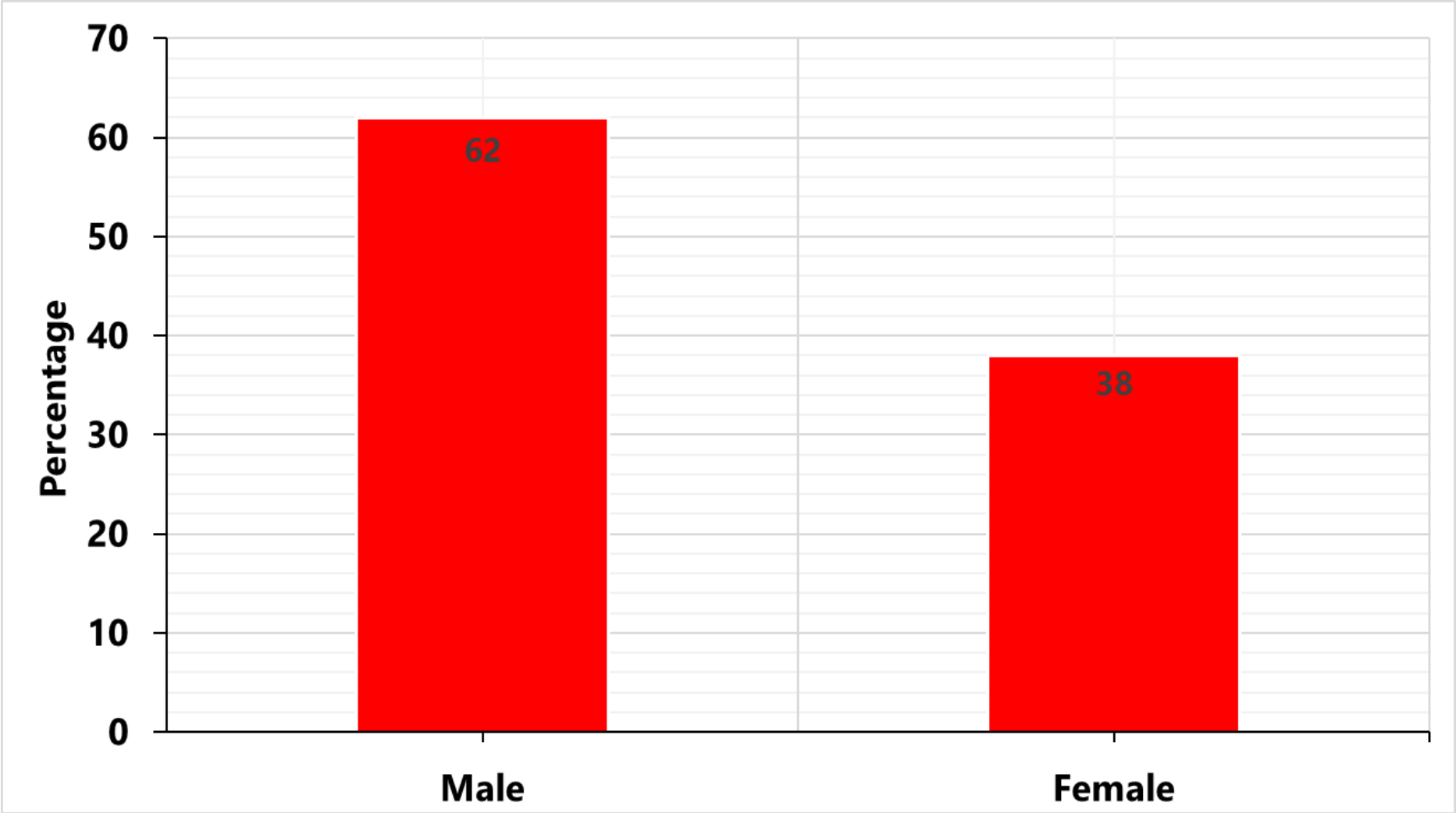

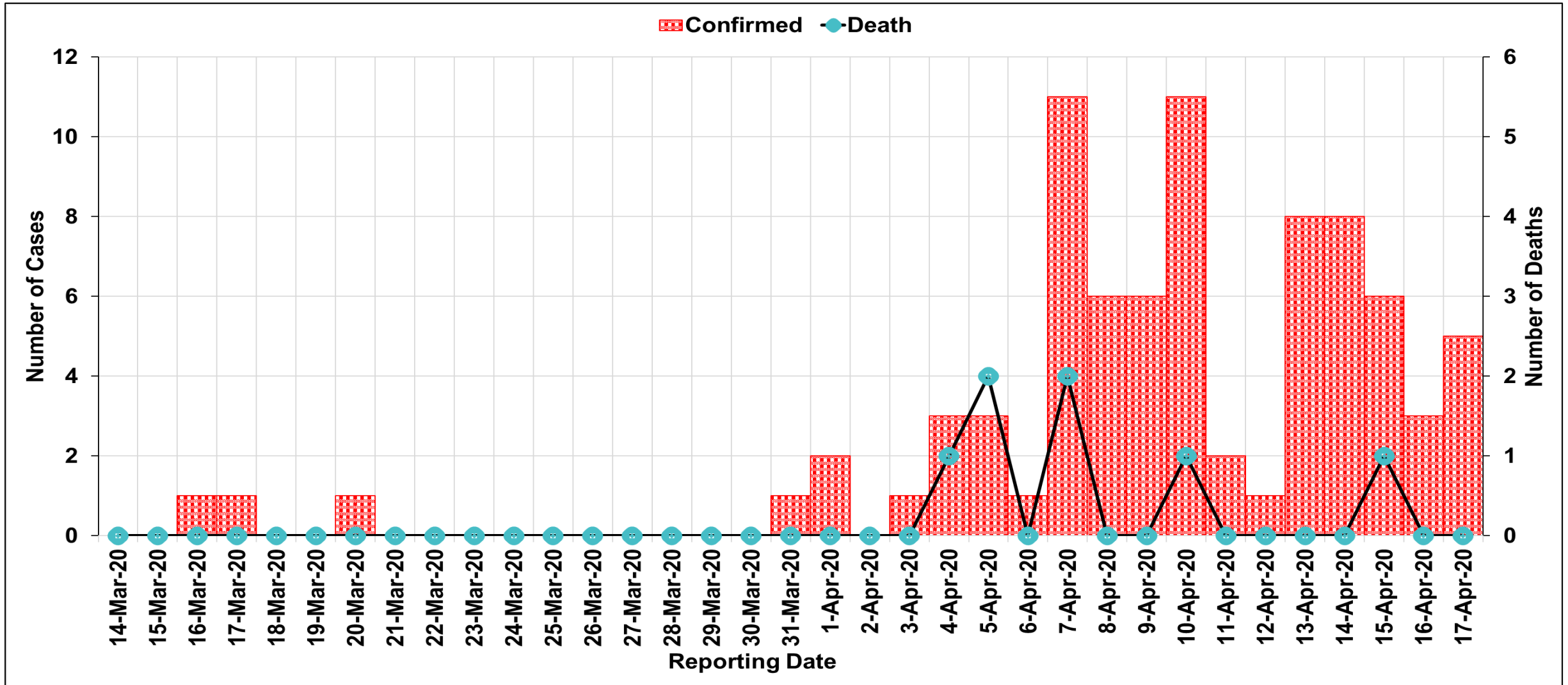

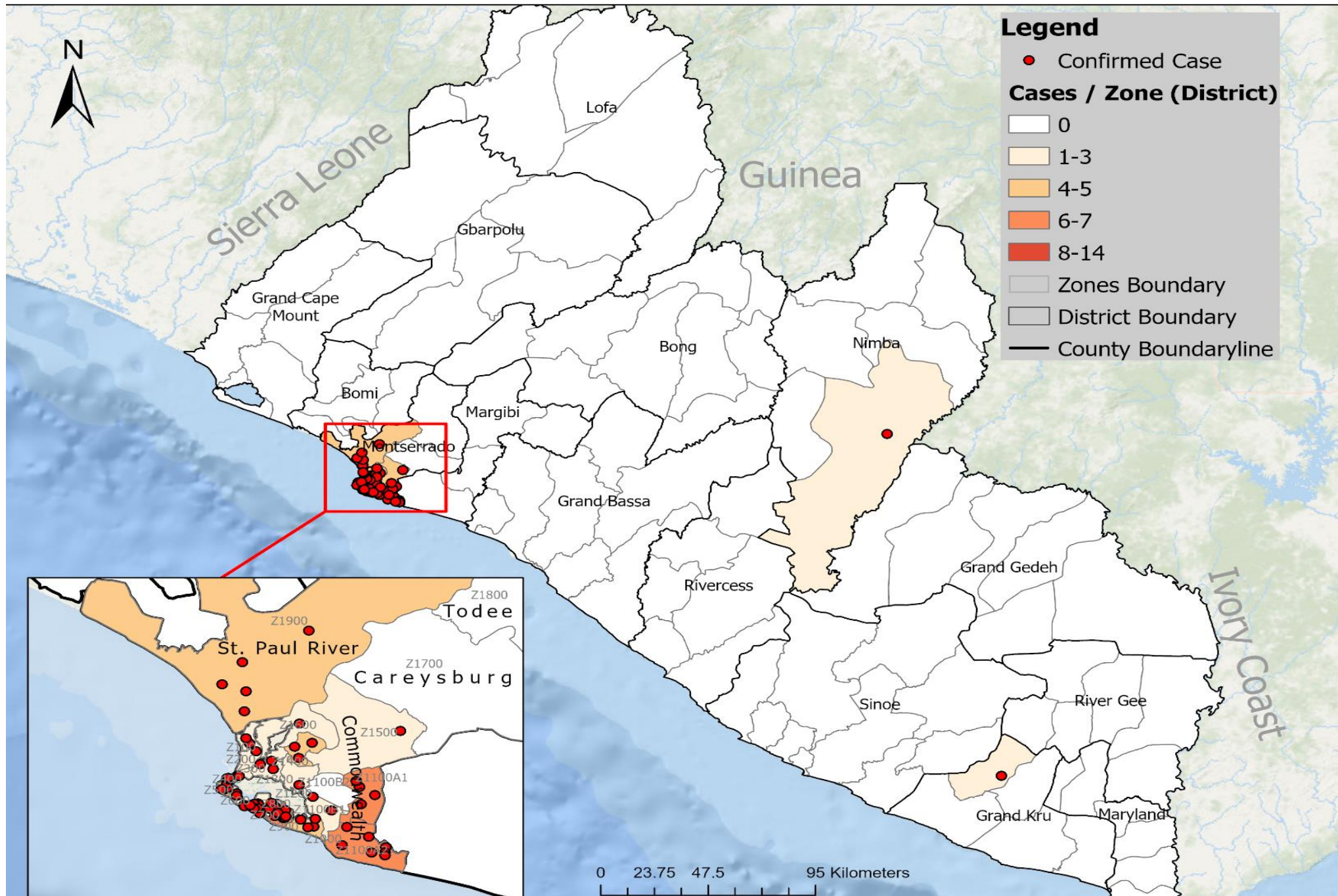

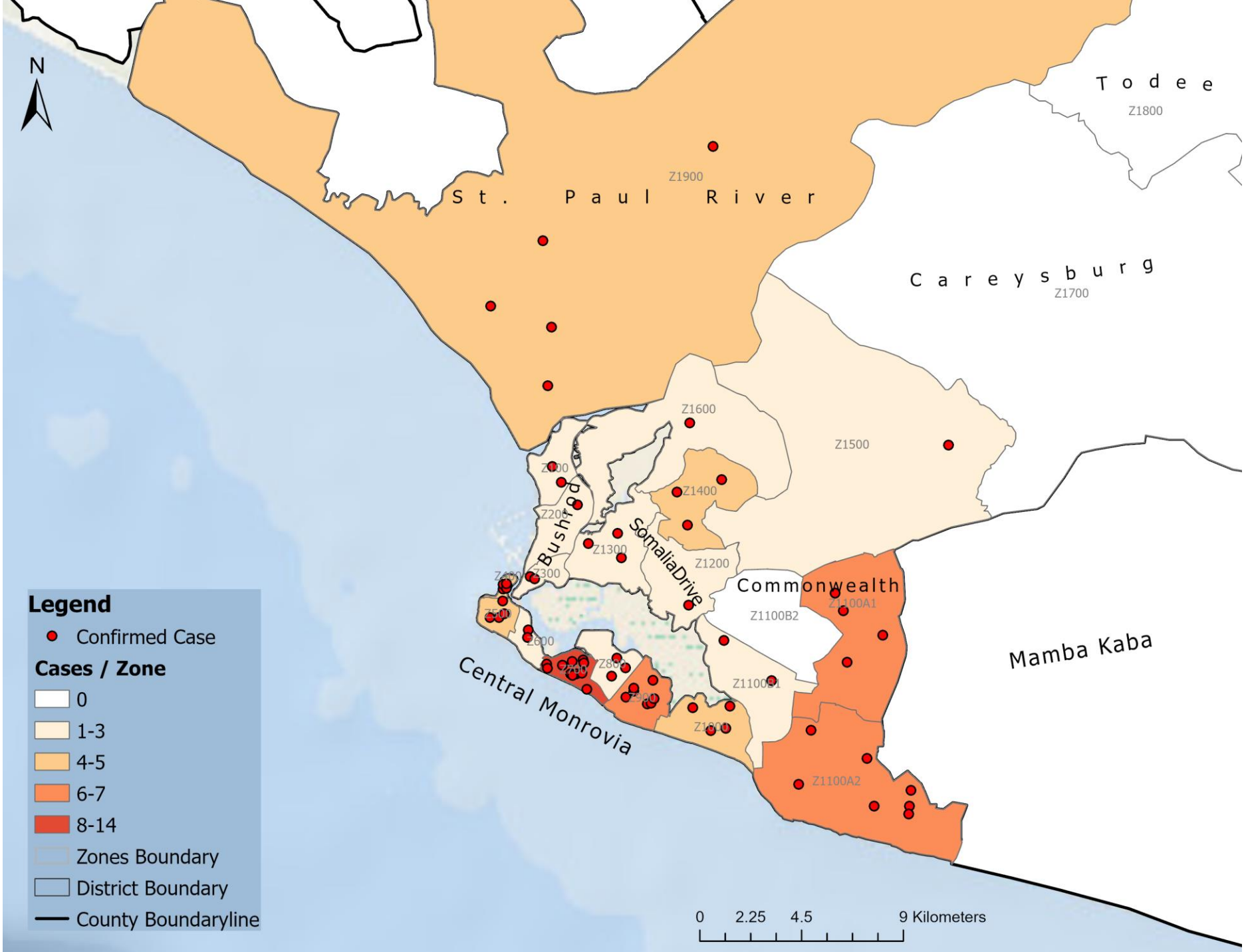
Percentage Distribution of Confirmed cases by Gender, 17 April 2020

Action points

- To enhance mhealth reporting:
 - Request the Liberia Telecommunication Authority (LTA) to engage mobile operators:
 - To authorize customization of its USSD platform for contact tracing and risk assessment
 - To provide “zero rated” authorization for data collection and reporting
- Seven hundred (700) sim cards to be picked up from Lonestar Cell MTN to support contact tracing
- Support training of case investigators on Sunday
